

KASEP COVID-19 Safety Protocol: December 1, 2021

KASEP will be following the current District and County COVID safety measures during the winter program. This may include, but is not limited to, smaller class sizes, outdoor activities when possible, and any current mask mandate. We will continue with our elevated cleaning and sanitizing of high touch surfaces and bathrooms as well as practicing repetitive mask protocol, hand washing, and social distancing when possible. All of the KCC staff and teachers have been vaccinated against Covid-19.

You play an important part in keep KASEP and our community safe. Please follow these covid-19 safety protocols:

- Monitor your child's health with daily temperature and health questions.
- If your child is not feeling well or has a fever, do not send them to KASEP classes.
- If your child is not yet fully vaccinated and has been directly exposed (unmasked, for 15 minutes or more to someone who has tested positive for Covid-19) they need to have a negative Covid-19 test to be able to return to KASEP.
- If anyone in the household has a positive Covid-19 test, do not send your child to KASEP until they have a negative test reported. There will be no refunds for missed classes, however this will ensure that their place is held for their return.
- Please call our office to report any positive Covid-19 cases at 510-525-0292.

Failure to comply with these regulations may result in your child's suspension from KASEP classes for the remainder of the session.
